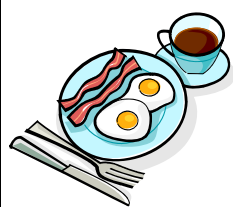

30 HOUR FAMINE: Get signed up and start collecting. The famine event starts at 5am with breakfast and ends on February 19th at communion. Envelopes are available.

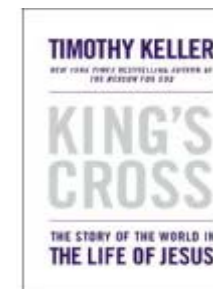

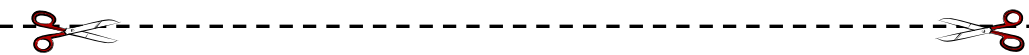
- Mozambique-Church and school building
